At Acts 15:1,2 Now some men came down from Ju·de'a and began to teach the brothers: "Unless you get circumcised according to the custom of Moses,you cannot be saved." 2 But after quite a bit of dissension and disputing by Paul and Bar'na·bas with them, it was arranged for Paul, Bar'na·bas, and some of the others to go up to the apostles and elders in Jerusalemb regarding this issue.

These men were God's mouthpiece, spokesperson, they had the Holy Spirit, but they teaching "Unless you get circumcised was not truth, they were not perfect.

God's servants are not perfect so they will get some of their teaching wrong.

(1John 5:8 [NIV2]) – based on the minority text (I do not support modern translations as they are not the most literal – [listen to NIV translator on the subject](#) His name is Dr Kenneth Barker)

The Spirit, the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement.

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Jeremiah 32:18 the One showing loyal love to thousands, but repaying the error of the fathers to their sons after them, the true God, the great and mighty One, whose name is Jehovah of armies. Thou shewest mercy unto thousands, and returnest the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: O most mighty, great, and powerful, the Lord of hosts is thy name.

Young's Literal Translation (I do not support modern translations as they are not the most literal – [listen to NIV translator on the subject](#))

Doing kindness to thousands, and recompensing iniquity of fathers into the bosom of their sons after them; God, the great, the mighty, Jehovah of Hosts is His name,.

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Jeremiah 32:16, Then I prayed to Jehovah after giving the deed of purchase to Bar'uch the son of Ne-ri'ah, saying: 17 "Alas, O Sovereign Lord Jehovah! Look! You made the heavens and the earth by your great powerp and by your outstretched arm. Nothing is too wonderful for you, 18 the One showing loyal love to thousands, but repaying the error of the fathers to\* their sons after them,q the true God, the great and **mighty One**, whose name is Jehovah of armies.

Interesting verse you chose (**mighty one** translated incorrectly). I will take this opportunity to point out something to you. The Mighty God refers to Yeshua (Jesus) as we both agree (I know Russell's false doctrine well). Where we disagree; I believe that the mighty God is Jehovah, which is Yeshua. However, you do not believe such. I will now show you why I believe from my foundation (Bible – KJV). Remember to study from the most literal bible (kjb) and not the others (niv, asv etc). Listen to the video and you will understand what I am saying is true.

The word used for Mighty God in the following is the same Hebrew word used in other verses. Examine what the WT did to hide this fact.

(Isa 9:6 [KJV]) **WT made no change here.**

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The **mighty God**, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

(Deut 7:21 [KJV]) **WT changed mighty God here to read "fear-inspiring" God. Why? It will make Jehovah's name mighty God as it occurs in the same verse. Can't have this as it does not agree with Russell; so what they do? Put in its place fear-inspiring – utter folly.**

Thou shalt not be affrighted at them: for the LORD thy God is among you, a **mighty God** and terrible.

(Isa 10:21 [KJV]) – Here God is called the **Mighty God** (same Hebrew word gibbowr, however, WT missed this one and translated it correctly).

The remnant shall return, even the remnant of Jacob, unto the **mighty God**.

(Jer 32:18 [KJV]) – WT again makes a change here to mighty “one” in the NWT and not mighty God as in the KJV (same Hebrew word miss-translated). Why? Same reason as in Deut 7:21. This time they replace the word for God with “one” – more utter folly.

Thou shewest lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompensest the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the **Mighty God**, the LORD of hosts, is his name,

The conclusion based on a literal and honest translation of the Bible (KJV) is as follows (Remember: the conclusion is from the Bible and not lying Russell):

1.

The **Mighty God** is called the Prince of Peace (Isa 9:6). Yeshua is called both the **Mighty God** and the Prince of Peace (the child that was born).

2.

Jehovah is called **Mighty God** (in the original language) and this means that Yeshua is Jehovah (Isa 9:6 and Deut 7:21)

The word for **mighty** in Hebrew used in the above verses by the Holy Spirit:

H1368 גִּבּוֹר gibbowr (ghib-bore') adj.

גִּבּוֹר gibbor (ghib-bore') [shortened]

1. powerful.

2. (by implication) a warrior, tyrant.

[intensive from the same as H1397]

KJV: champion, chief, X excel, giant, man, **mighty** (man, one), strong (man), valiant man.

Root(s): H1397

I can give you tons more erroneous mistranslations done by the NWT, but we are just dealing with the **Mighty God**.

Question: Why would WT change around words to support Russell's theology?

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John 5:57, Then said the Jews unto him, (Thou art not yet fifty years old,) and hast thou seen Abraham? 58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.
